

GPS availability is extremely important to me as I use this technology in my land surveying practice. This technology cannot afford the possibility of widespread disruption due to adjacent radio frequency interference. I am not opposed to broadband high-speed internet connections for the public but the GPS interference that I have had during testing by LightSquared is unacceptable. My business depends on being able to use the GPS data. In addition, I use satellite navigation to locate addresses, navigate in wilderness areas and on Lake Mead, etc. The loss of productivity resulting from GPS interference would seriously affect my ability to compete as a small business. I believe that other areas of the radio frequency spectrum should be made available to LightSquared for their broadband project. The use of GPS is simply too important to the economy of our country to interfere with this technology. Make other portions of the spectrum available to LightSquared where the interference would not affect so many businesses and other GPS users.
