On Wednesday, July 13, 2011, Bruce Franca and Kelly Williams of the National Association of Broadcasters (NAB) met with the following members of the Office of Engineering and Technology, Julius Knapp, Alan Stillwell, Geraldine Matisse, Karen Ansari, and Hugh Van Tuyl.

We discussed and reiterated points made in our Opposition to Petitions for Reconsideration, filed February 24, 2011. Specifically, we stated that the out-of-band emission limits should not be relaxed. We noted that the request was procedurally deficient, that no technical justification was filed to support such a change, and that several parties have already developed and built compliant equipment. We also discussed our proposed maximum antenna height compromise. As indicated in our filing we suggested that a combination maximum HAAT of 250 meters with a 30 meter limit on antenna height along with some other concomitant restrictions would meet many of the concerns raised by the rural WISP community.
