Dear Ms. Dortch:

On July 20, 2011, Consumer Cellular, Inc. (“Consumer Cellular” or “CCI”) met with Kimberly Scardino and Divya Shenoy of the FCC regarding Consumer Cellular’s still-pending Compliance Plan, filed on August 27, 2010, pursuant to the Commission’s order granting Consumer Cellular’s Petition for Forbearance. During the meeting Consumer Cellular discussed how it might modify its Compliance Plan to better address certain Commission concerns identified in the Commission’s Lifeline NPRM. Specifically, Consumer Cellular discussed how it would help to ensure that consumers understood Lifeline eligibility rules (from a 1 line per household standpoint), and how it would maintain proof of consumer eligibility at the time of enrollment. Consumer Cellular noted that it would file with the Commission certain modifications to its existing Compliance Plan in the near future.
