On July 27, 2011 the undersigned, on behalf of Snap Telecommunications, Inc. (“Snap!VRS”), met with Paul de Sa, Chief, Office of Strategic Planning and Policy Analysis and Nicholas Alexander of the Wireline Competition Bureau.

We discussed the FCC’s pending plans to issue a Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking that would propose changes to the reimbursement structure for the video relay industry from a per minute basis to a per active user basis, as well as compensation for broadband and expansion of relay services to new users. We also reviewed the potential ramifications for such a transition including functional equivalency and assurance of consumer choice of providers, interoperability standards, tie-in to mainstream technologies, and continued provision of innovative and high quality video relay services.
