This letter is submitted pursuant to Section 1.1206(b)(2)(iv) of the Commission's rules to provide notice that on August 2, 2011, on behalf of Comsearch, Bryan Tramont and Timothy Cooney of this firm spoke by telephone with Louis Peraertz, Legal Advisor Wireless for Commissioner Mignon Clyburn, to discuss the rulemaking proceeding pending in the above-referenced dockets. We expressed Comsearch's continued strong opposition to the auxiliary station proposal and how it would lead to spectrum inefficiencies and be disruptive to the Part 101 point-to-point microwave service by mixing TDD services into bands that had been exclusively FDD.
