Pursuant to section 1.1206 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206, governing permit-but-disclose proceedings, this letter serves to notify the Federal Communications Commission (FCC or Commission) of a meeting with the National Congress of American Indians (NCAI) that took place at the NCAI's Embassy of Tribal Nations in Washington, D.C. on August 5, 2011. Jacqueline Johnson Pata, NCAI Executive Director, Loris Ann Taylor, NCAI Telecommunications Subcommittee Chair, and Brian Howard, NCAI Legislative Fellow, together with FCC staff from the Office of Native Affairs and Policy, Geoffrey Blackwell, Chief, Irene Flannery, Deputy Chief, and Cynthia Bryant, Senior Legal Advisor, met to discuss several resolutions regarding FCC policy actions. These resolutions were recently adopted by the Tribal Nations of NCAI at the NCAI Mid Year Conference in Milwaukee, WI, June 13 to 16, 2011. This discussion was subject to public disclosure under section 1.1206(b)(1) of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 1.1206 (b)(1). The discussion focused on reviewing the content of the resolutions to determine the appropriate docket in which to file them.
