On Friday, August 12, 2011, Mike Simpson, Cynthia Cole, and Todd Early, representing the State of Texas, John Chaney and Robert Cavazos, representing Harris County, TX and Gino Scribano, Mark Poulin, Craig Reilly, and Chuck Powers, all from Motorola Solutions, Inc, met with Jennifer Manner, Gene Fullano, Pat Amodio, Behzad Ghaffari, Yoon Chang, and Brian Hurley, all of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau.

During the meeting, additional questions and suggestions the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau had regarding the latest version of Interoperability Showing Technical and Operational Response for the State of Texas 700 MHz broadband Public Safety network, which was filed with the Commission on August 3, 2011 were discussed.

Topics addressed in the Interoperability Showing that were discussed included:

- Adjustment to the references to the nationwide network governance entity
- Remove technical test detail in executive summary objectives section
- In Inter-state process section, remove the requirement for other PS entities to submit Interoperability Showing when requesting connectivity and access
- Clarify requests from qualified entities for access and roaming must be honored
- Make sure number of sites identified in various deployment descriptions show consistent number of sites
- Remove the detailed technical dependency information in the Mobility and Handover section
- Wherever appropriate throughout entire document, add language which articulates the commitment to FCC requirements; focus on the *Waiver Order*
- Reduce the number of problem statements in testing section

- Summarize all commitments to compliance in Appendix F; the Commission provided some specific guidance on how to approach this item.

Based on the discussions that took place during this meeting, it is expected that a revised version of the Interoperability Showing will be filed with the Commission by the State of Texas no later than August 18, 2011.
