Dear Ms. Dortch:

On August 15, 2011, Aaron Wegehaupt, Vice President of Operations, and the undersigned of CSDVRS, LLC (“CSDVRS”) met with Karen Peltz Strauss, Deputy Chief, Consumer and Governmental Affairs Bureau, Gregory Hlibok, Chief, and Diane Mason, Attorney Advisor, Disability Rights Office. CSDVRS discussed the benefit to the public interest in granting its petition for a temporary waiver so that it may ensure interpreter safety and consistently high speed of answer by allowing for a small percentage of its video interpreters to continue to work from secure virtual call centers. CSDVRS indicated that it was amenable to a waiver limited to overnight shifts, and at the same time expressed a view that a broader waiver would enable it to ensure consistent coverage during unforeseeable circumstances affecting geographical regions such as severe weather conditions. CSDVRS said that it would regularly report certain data to assist the Commission and the Fund Administrator in assessing the effects of the waiver.
