I was recently victimized by Verizon Wireless 3 times within about a year, ostensibly by "administrative error", and then was told by a VZW manager that I couldn't get my money refunded, because I didn't notice their overcharges soon enough to notify them that they had been overcharging me by \$49.99/month. It took a letter to the FCC before they suddenly saw it my way, and refunded what I had coming. However, I am sure that they won't ever do anything more than they are compelled to do. VZW had added on a "data package", an extra service from which I was specifically exempted when I bought my phone. I had them remove this 3 times. They just kept adding it back in every few months.

"Cramming" is a lot like that, or like "spamming". They attempt to overload people with unwanted, unsolicited services. It is bad when shady individuals do that stuff. It is much worse when very large communications corporations do it. And, when it is done surreptitiously and without permission, it becomes illegal, and basically a felony.
