Dear Ms. Dortch:

The Public Safety Spectrum Trust Corporation ("PSST") hereby provides notice of a permitted *ex parte* communication. On Wednesday, August 31, 2011, Chief Harlin R. McEwen, Chairman of the PSST, along with Alan Caldwell, Secretary-Treasurer of the PSST, and Michele C. Farquhar of Hogan Lovells US LLP, counsel to the PSST, met with Jennifer Manner, Brian Hurley, Pat Amodio, and Behzad Ghaffari of the FCC's Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau ("PSHSB").

During the meeting, the parties discussed recent ATIS Wireless Technologies and Systems Committee and IMSI Oversight Council developments concerning Public Land Mobile Network Identifiers ("PLMN IDs"). They also discussed public safety's support for a single, nationwide PLMN ID approach due to the simplicity of management and lower cost. In addition, the parties discussed the pressing need for the FCC to address and resolve the PLMN ID issue raised in the *Fourth Further Notice of Proposed Rulemaking* in the above-referenced proceeding as public safety early deployment waiver recipients start planning to begin operations in the coming months. Chief McEwen also responded to questions from PSHSB staff regarding PLMN ID administrative and governance issues and the role of the PSST or other governance structures proposed by pending legislation.
