I have worked for several years as executive director of the West Virginia Hospitality & Travel Association (WVHTA), which is the official voice of the food service, lodging, convention and visitors bureaus, and travel industries in the state. I recognize that, as the national economy continues to teeter, nervous Americans are having second thoughts about vacationing, traveling, and eating out.
