

To Federal Communications Commission Chairman Julius Genachowski, Commissioners Michael Copps, Mignon Clyburn and Robert McDowell,

Should the FCC make the unfortunate choice to approve the AT&T T Mobil merger despite all the facts pointing out that it should be denied (have filed comments before against the merger myself as have others providing factual evidence to back up our claims/opinions that it should be denied) and the Justice Department filing an antitrust lawsuit to stop it I ask that the agency extend its Net Neutrality rule to wireless services. I also strongly urge the agency to reconsider using Title I and reclassify broadband as a public utility/advanced telecommunications service under Title II so the agency can have statutory authority to protect users and innovators online from ISP discrimination. So if you decide to approve this merger I hope that you will mandate wireless net neutrality to preserve free and open neutral access to the web for wireless users.

Otherwise we could end up with a two-tiered Internet carved up where the fixed wire-line Internet we get access to from the duopoly big cable and phone company providers of broadband service are properly regulated and have to comply with Network Neutrality but the wireless providers are exempt and can discriminate. If its wrong for wire-line providers to be allowed to discriminate its wrong for wireless providers to discriminate.

Furthermore, Internet companies like Google, Facebook, Yahoo, Twitter etc should be very worried about the anti competitive and anti consumer merger. Considering if the deal goes through there will be fewer providers in the wireless market -- especially afterward if more acquisitions are approved resulting in less consumer choice there will be fewer providers for these companies to work with to ensure their services can be accessed over the carrier's network etc. Furthermore, the combined AT&T T Mobil/Qualcomm will have more incentive to discriminate post-merger than prior to the merger with more market power/dominance it could abuse that dominance in the wireless market.

So weigh all the facts and decide accordingly but urge you reject the merger to deny Ma Bell a Ma Cell. However, should you approve the merger I ask only that you extend Net Neutrality to wireless and mandate wireless service providers also comply with it to prevent ISP discrimination in the wireless space. Mobile broadband providers should also be subject to Net Neutrality especially if there's reduced competition.

Again its your call but urge you to mandate wireless Net Neutrality if you do approve the deal but prefer that you oppose the deal.
