ORDER

By second Motion to Continue ("Motion") filed by Glen Baxter ("Baxter") on August 10, 2011, Mr. Baxter seeks further continuance of pre-hearing procedures in this case pending the outcome of an ongoing collection action in a U.S. District Court which litigates issues relevant to this proceeding. By *Order* FCC 11M-04 (rel. February 15, 2011) the Presiding Judge rescheduled a prehearing conference for September 7, 2011.

On August 17, 2011, the Enforcement Bureau ("Bureau") filed a Response to Second Motion to Continue which suggests a continuance conditioned on Mr. Baxter filing a Status Report in lieu of holding a conference. The Bureau's suggestion is reasonable and seems appropriate under the circumstances.

Accordingly IT IS ORDERED that Prehearing Conference scheduled for September 7, 2011, IS CANCELLED *sine die*.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **by 12 noon on September 7, 2011**, Mr. Baxter shall file a Status Report that discloses: (a) the status of the U.S. District Court action which includes describing the last (latest) information issued by the court (e.g. order on status; instructions to parties); (b) the expected date of decision on pending motion for summary judgment; (c) status of discovery by the government and made by Mr. Baxter in the U.S. District Court case; and (d) the name, address, phone number, and fax number of Mr. Baxter's attorney of record, if any, in the U.S. District Court Case.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that **by 12 noon on September 14, 2011**, the Bureau shall describe the extent of its discovery to date and any expected further discovery deemed necessary for hearing preparation, and the estimated date that the Bureau shall be ready for hearing, assuming reasonable cooperation by Mr. Baxter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, that **by 12 noon on October 7, 2011**, Mr. Baxter and the

Bureau shall file second Status Reports that update status of the U.S. District Court case, and that describes any discovery taken or noticed since September 14, 2011, in the U.S. District Court action.
