As owner of the entity, No Automagraph Entertainment, Rafiq Mustafaa, I respectfully submit this petition requesting exemption from the Federal Communications Commission's Closed Captioning requirements on the basis of "undue financial burden".

To provide closed captioning for this series would cost No Automagraph Entertainment \$11,440. Nearly all of No Automagraph's cast and crew provide their services and talents on a volunteer basis, and the revenue the company takes in is just enough to keep the company afloat. Unfortunately, there just are not enough funds to pay for closed captioning for the "Once an Adult, Twice a Child" series. The nature of the programming is health awareness.

We hope the FCC grants our petition for an exemption of the closed captioning requirement on the basis that providing closed captioning would prove to be an undue financial burden on No Automagraph Entertainment.
