On September 15, 2011, Christopher Guttman-McCabe, Vice President, Regulatory Affairs, and Brian Josef, Assistant Vice President, Regulatory Affairs, CTIA – The Wireless Association® (“CTIA”), met with Sherrese Smith, Senior Counsel and Legal Advisor, Amy Levine, Special Counsel and Legal Advisor, and Jessica Almond, Special Counsel, all in the Office of Chairman Genachowski.

The parties to the meeting discussed the Commission’s “Bill Shock” proceeding.
