On September 17, the undersigned of Verizon and Scott Angstreich of Kellogg Huber representing Verizon, met with Angela Kronenberg, Wireline Legal Advisor to Commissioner Mignon Clyburn. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss America's Broadband Connectivity Plan ("ABC Plan") and background information regarding the Commission's intercarrier compensation orders and resulting court decisions. Specifically, we discussed Sections 251 and 252 of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, and Commission orders addressing dial-up internet traffic as well as the jurisdiction of intermodal traffic and identification of call "end points." We also discussed federal pre-emption analysis and related appellate cases.
