On September 17, Alan Buzacott and the undersigned of Verizon, Jeff Lanning of CenturyLink, Christopher Heimann and David Hostetter of AT&T, Mike Saperstein of Frontier, and Malena Barzilai of Windstream, met with Rebekah Goodheart, Randy Clarke, Doug Slotten, and Travis Litman of the Wireline Competition Bureau. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss America's Broadband Connectivity Plan ("ABC Plan") and other intercarrier compensation reform proposals as well as changes to the Commission's various rules that may be necessary to implement reforms. Specifically, we discussed provisions of Parts, 51, 64, and 69 of the Commission's rules and modifications to those provisions that may be necessary in order for the Commission to adopt a single, national default per-minute terminating rate for traffic that connects with the PSTN. We also discussed Commission rules with respect to subscriber line charges, potential access charge replacement revenue recovery, and VoIP intercarrier compensation charges.
