SECTION 63.71 APPLICATION

Insight Phone of Illinois, LLC ("Insight Illinois") hereby submits this application under Section 63.71 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, to discontinue domestic common carrier services.

Insight Illinois offers and is capable of providing domestic interexchange service. Insight Illinois currently has no customers for this service. Subject to the Commission's authorization of the proposed discontinuance, Insight will discontinue domestic interexchange service in Illinois effective upon receiving discontinuance authority from the Commission.¹

Affiliates of Insight Illinois that provide service in Kentucky and Ohio will continue to operate. Consequently, this application does not affect their operation or the international Section 214 authorization held by Insight Illinois affiliate Insight Midwest Holdings, LLC.²

As required by Sections 63.71(a) and (b) of the Commission's rules, Insight Illinois provides the following information:

1. Name and Address of Carrier:

2. Date of Planned Service Discontinuance:

Subject to the Commission's authorization of the proposed discontinuance pursuant to Section 63.71 of the Commission's rules, Insight Illinois will discontinue domestic interexchange service upon receiving discontinuance authority from the Commission.

3. Points of Geographic Areas of Service Affected:

Insight Illinois is authorized to provide domestic interexchange service in Illinois, but because the service has no customers, there are no geographic areas within which customers will be affected by this discontinuance.

4. Brief Description of Type of Service Affected:

Insight Illinois is authorized to provide domestic interexchange service in Illinois. Insight Illinois is currently offering and is capable of providing domestic interexchange service to customers in Illinois, but has no current customers.

5. Brief Description of the Dates and Methods of Notice to All Affected Customers:

Because there are no customers for Insight's domestic interexchange service, there are no customers to notify concerning the proposed discontinuance. Insight Illinois has served both the Governor of Illinois and the Illinois Commerce Commission with copies of this Application. Furthermore, as required by Section 63.71 of the Commission's rules, Insight Illinois has mailed a copy of this Application to the Special Assistant for Telecommunications to the Secretary of Defense.

6. Regulatory Classification of Carrier:

Insight Illinois is considered non-dominant with respect to the service to be discontinued.


