
Deutsche Telekom AG (“DT”), by its attorneys, filed a response (the “Response”) on June 10 to the information request provided to DT and T-Mobile USA, Inc. in the above-referenced docket on May 27, 2011. In the June 10 Response, DT and TMUS made diligent efforts to ensure that no documents in the Document Production were privileged under the attorney-client privilege or attorney work product doctrine. However, as a result of ongoing discussions with the Department of Justice (“DOJ”), DT has identified certain documents that were mistakenly withheld on the grounds of privilege. Those documents are now being produced and are attached to this filing.

The attached materials contain highly confidential information subject to the Second Protective Order (DA 11-753) in the above-referenced proceeding.
