On September 29, 2011, the Voice on the Net Coalition (VON), represented by Paula Boyd of Microsoft and VON Executive Director Glenn Richards, met with Dave Grimaldi and Louis Peraertz, from the office of Commissioner Clyburn; separately the same day, Mr. Richards met with Angela Kronenberg from Commissioner Clyburn's office and Angela Giancarlo from Commissioner McDowell's office; and on September 30, Ms. Boyd and Mr. Richards met with Margaret McCarthy from Commissioner Copps' office to discuss the Commission's implementation of the Twenty-First Century Communications and Video Accessibility Act of 2010 in the above-referenced dockets. VON discussed its support for the items and addressed other issues raised in VON's filings in the above-referenced proceedings, including the scope of the decisions, the potential impact on software providers, timeframe for resolving waivers and the impact on innovation if the Commission imposes TRS fees on bundled product or services that include the capability to provide non-interconnected VoIP.
