Due to end-of-year budget matters, there can be no conference held at this time. The first workable date is Tuesday, October 25, 2011. In the meantime, as a matter of Presiding Judge discretion, discovery shall remain static.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that active discovery shall temporarily cease, and parties have an option of responding to outstanding discovery requests.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that a Prehearing Conference IS SCHEDULED for **Tuesday, October 25, 2011, at 10 a.m.** in the Commission courtroom (TW A-363).

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the agenda SHALL INCLUDE (a) status of Bankruptcy proceeding; (b) Maritime's progress in obtaining purchaser(s) for license(s) in connection with Bankruptcy proceeding; (c) status and scope of discovery already commenced by Enforcement Bureau and Skytel/Havens and affiliated or related companies ("Skytel").

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED there shall be submitted a Status Report on (1) further discovery needed and (2) any agenda topics desired for Conference discussion by Maritime, Enforcement Bureau, and Skytel by **Thursday, October 20, 2011, before 3 p.m.**
