On October 7, 2011, Cher Wang, Chairwoman, and Amy Wolverson, Executive Director of Public Policy and Government Affairs, of HTC America ("HTC") and Ker Zhang, Advisor to the Chairwoman of HTC and CEO of VIA Telecom, Inc., met with Chairman Julius Genachowski, Rick Kaplan, Wireless Bureau Chief, and Amy Levine, Senior Counsel and Legal Advisor to the Chairman, to introduce HTC and discuss matters related the above-referenced proceedings.

During the meeting, HTC's representatives emphasized the company's commitment to innovation and the wireless mobile marketplace in the United States. Expressing support for the FCC's National Broadband Plan, Ms. Wang specifically noted the increasing need for more spectrum and healthy competition to drive further innovation and broadband deployment. In response to questions, HTC's representatives agreed that WiFi technologies will continue play an important role in bringing advanced communications devices to consumers.
