

Good day my comment today is about the National Do-Not-Call List (LIST) and expanding its jurisdiction to improve American's lives. Currently the LIST does not cover non-business organizations such as charities or especially with elections, Political Action Committees (PACs). I get calls from PACs or other political organizations that I have never dealt with, gave my permission to call me or donated money and yet I ask them how did they get my phone number? Often they say that it was from exchanging mailing lists or that I gave phone number to another PAC or political organization. When I ask them to put me on their do-not-call they typically comply and sometimes they tell me that even though I am on the LIST that it (LIST) does not cover PACs or charities.

I propose these solutions. First is to expand the LIST's jurisdiction to include all businesses, charities, PACs, and organizations. The intent of the LIST is to reduce annoying phone calls, first by telemarketers and now let us include all sources of annoying calls, to include ROBO calls. Secondly, please tell me the process for changing this with the US Congress. Lastly, besides telling you and my elected officials, and/or news media's editorial pages and webpages, what can I do to expand the LIST to further protect Americans? Thank you FCC.
