**RE: Application of AT&T Inc. On Behalf Of AT&T Corp. To Discontinue Domestic Telecommunications Services, WC Docket No. 11-164**

Ms. Dortch:

On September 27, 2011, AT&T Inc. filed an application on behalf of its affiliate, AT&T Corp., requesting authority, under section 214 of the Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 214, and section 63.71 of the Commission's rules, 47 C.F.R. § 63.71, to discontinue Fractional T3 Channel service throughout the continental United States and the District of Columbia ("Application"). The Commission issued its Public Notice of this proposed discontinuance on October 14, 2011 ("Public Notice"). After reading the Public Notice, AT&T discovered that its Application contained a typographical error, which resulted in disclosing the incorrect year in which AT&T mailed its customer notification letters.

The Application indicated that the customer notifications were mailed on September 15, 2010 instead of September 15, 2011. The incorrect date was carried over into the Commission's Public Notice. The date stated on the customer notification (September 15, 2011), which was attached to the Application, is correct.
