Dear Ms. Dortch,

On April 15, 2011 Stephen Berger of TEM Consulting LP and Paul Schomburg of Panasonic Corporation meet with Mr. Charles Mathias on Commissioner. Baker's staff, on behalf of the DECT Forum. The meeting was held to discuss status, potential schedule and discuss the merits of FCC docket 10-97, which is a response to the DECT Forum's Petition for Rulemaking, reference in RM 11485. The representatives of the DECT Forum reviewed the petition and the reasons for it. The DECT Forum representatives noted that the requested changes to the UPCS band would avoid an interference problem with the proposed AWS band and enable new broadband data applications in DECT systems, such as music streaming, health worker communication in medical facilities, or smart grid device connections in consumer homes. The discussions centered on the merits of improving the interference immunity of UPCS devices in anticipation of AWS deployment, the current status of the item and its likely course. The attached White Paper was presented as part of these discussions.
