On October 20, 2011, the undersigned and Stacey Black, AT&T Assistant Vice President—Market Development, engaged in a telephone conversation with Jennifer Manner, Deputy Bureau Chief of the Public Safety and Homeland Security Bureau (“PSHSB”) and Genaro Fullano of the PSHSB pertaining to the request by the State of Texas for a PLMN ID for the public safety broadband network Texas is deploying. Specifically, AT&T expressed its opinion that it is technically and operationally feasible to deploy and operate a nationwide public safety network with a single PLMN ID. Further, the participants on the call discussed the nature of the questions posed by James Barnett, Chief of the PSHSB to Mike Simpson, Chief-Interoperable Communications, Texas Department of Public Safety, by letter dated October 12, 2011.
