COMMENTS OF MULTI-CULTURAL DIVERSITY RADIO, INC.

Multi-Cultural Diversity Radio, Inc. ("Multi-Cultural") hereby submits its comments to a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, released September 9, 2011 (DA 11-1523), in which the Audio Division of the Media Bureau proposes to delete twenty vacant FM channel allotments in various communities, including an allotment at Tigerton, Wisconsin, channel 295A (106.9 MHz) (the "Tigerton Channel"), because no bids were entered for these channel allotments in FM Auction 91. Multi-Cultural requests that the Tigerton Channel allotment not be deleted from the FM Table of Allotments and in support thereof sets forth the following.

1. Multi-Cultural was incorporated on October 6, 2011 for the purpose of participating in FM Auction 93, scheduled for March 27, 2012. The principals of Multi-Cultural first become aware of the Tigerton Channel upon release of the above-captioned Notice of Proposed Rulemaking on September 9, 2011; in any event, however, they were not financially positioned to participate in previous broadcast auctions when the Tigerton Channel had been put

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up for bid (the Tigerton Channel allotment was offered in both FM Auction 79, completed on September 15, 2009, and FM Auction 91, completed on May 11, 2011, and in each auction attracted no bids).

2. Multi-Cultural requests that the Tigerton Channel allocation not be deleted from the FM Table of Allotments, but that such vacant allotment be retained and offered for bid in a future auction; in which event Multi-Cultural intends to participate in such future auction for the purpose of bidding on the Tigerton Channel allocation. In support of the comments of Multi-Cultural, there is set forth the attached statement of Samir Abumayyaleh.

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

STATEMENT OF Samir Abumayyaleh

Samir Abumayyaleh hereby states under penalty of perjury as follows:

1. I am a US. Citizen and a principal of Multi-Cultural Diversity Radio, Inc. ("Multi-Cultural"), Federal EIN number 45-3556990, which was incorporated in the State of Wisconsin on October 6, 2011.
2. Multi-Cultural was formed for the purpose of participating in FM Auction 93 schedule to begin on March 27, 2012.
3. I first became aware of the vacant FM channel allocation at Tigerton (channel 295A, 106.9 MHz) on or about September 9, 2011, the date of release of a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking (MM Docket 11-147) in which the Audio Division, Media Bureau, proposed the deletion of the Tigerton allocation in that no bids had been entered for this allotment in FM Auction 91 and a previous auction.
4. Should the Tigerton channel allotment be retained in the FM Table of Allotments and offered for bid in a future auction, it is the intention of Multi-Cultural to participate in such future auction and to actively bid on the Tigerton allotment.
