Myteleservice is a Delaware company located in Minnesota. We offer Enhanced Voicemail services to thousands of consumers throughout the US.


We believe that third-party billing is a vital practice that allows smaller companies to compete with larger corporations, by allowing them alternative ways to bill customers for services they provide. By enacting a complete ban on all third-party billing, the FCC would essentially eliminate 75% of existing customers and the competitive edge that smaller companies now enjoy.

Myteleservice recognizes that there are currently several issues relating to third-party billing that must be addressed. However, the various clearinghouses, such as Billing Services Group (BSG), have made tremendous progress by tightening their requirements for processing records to the home phone bill that have significantly improved the reliability of the billing process.

Therefore, Myteleservice does not believe that a complete ban of third-party billing is a reasonable solution. We believe that a complete ban of third-party billing will ultimately affect numerous businesses and jobs, and urges the FCC to reconsider their proposal.
