Dear Chairman Genachowski:

This is to register our opposition to any FCC attempt to prohibit wireline carriers from including third party vendor charges on their bills.

We are in the business of providing 976 announcements for telephone customers in the state of New Jersey. We offer programs such as the time, weather and lottery announcements. It should be noted that our programs are savory in nature, not any at all of the variety which have given the "pay per call" business a bad rap in many quarters.

Our company has been providing this service since 1982, first as a vendor of the "telephone company" (then New Jersey Bell) and, since 2008 (when Verizon transferred the operation to us), as owner of the system.

We receive more than 60,000 calls per month from wireline users. All programs are less than \$1.00 per call. The vast majority of these callers are repeat customers. It is believed that many of these customers do not have access to the latest technology for the information we provide and, thus, cannot get it elsewhere.

Our revenue is obtained through billing via local exchange carrier. We have no other cost effective mechanism for which to invoice our customers.

To prohibit third party billing by wireline carriers would put us out of business and leave many thousands of New Jersey residents without a reliable service they've counted on for decades.
