Dear Ms. Dortch:

PTC-220, LLC ("PTC-220") hereby submits the Positive Train Control Implementation Plans ("PTCIPs") prepared by the three new members of PTC-220, LLC ("PTC-220"): Canadian National Railway Company ("Canadian National"), Canadian Pacific Railway Company ("Canadian Pacific"), and The Kansas City Southern Railway Company ("Kansas City Southern"). These PTCIPs, prepared pursuant to 49 C.F.R. § 236.1009(a) and § 236.1011, have been approved by the Federal Railroad Administration ("FRA").<sup>1</sup> The PTCIPs are being submitted as required by the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau's order of June 25, 2009 issued in the above-referenced docket.<sup>2</sup>

The attached PTCIP documents have been redacted to protect certain Sensitive Security Information ("SSI"),<sup>3</sup> as well as other information constituting confidential commercial and/or financial information.<sup>4</sup> Unredacted versions of the PTCIPs are being submitted by hand

On November 1, 2010, Kansas City Southern's PTCIP and Notice of Product Intent received provisional FRA approval. Non-provisional approval from FRA is pending. The Canadian National filing also contains a May 12, 2011 Request for Amendment ("RFA") of the PTCIP to remove the requirement to install PTC on a specified segment of track that no longer qualifies as main line track subject to PTC installation requirements. FRA approved the RFA on June 29, 2011.
