Deny AT&T T Mobil and AT&T Qualcomm already: No wireless telecommunications/technology duopoly

To date as you can tell from all my filings on the AT&T T Mobil merger I am strongly opposed to it. If the merger is approved believe wireless Network Neutrality should be back on the table. I support the UN Declaration on Internet Human Rights and while I support USF Reform I oppose the ABC Plan for doing so. The Christian Coalition has supported Net Neutrality but GOP now opposes it. I believe in a free and open Internet with no government or corporate censorship. We need more competition not less in national post-paid cellular phone market and increased choice. In past filings I have provided plenty of evidence against AT&T T Mobil and Qualcomm mergers.
