**SECOND SUPPLEMENT

Malka Communications Group, Inc. (“MCG”) hereby submits this Second Supplement¹ to its application for certification (“Application”) that MCG is eligible to receive reimbursement from the Interstate Telecommunications Relay Service Fund (“Fund”) as a provider of Video Relay Service (“VRS”) pursuant to 47 C.F.R. § 64.606, and the Commission’s *Certification Order*.²

MCG submits this Second Supplement to update information provided in its Application. Specifically, MCG hereby clarifies that it will not utilize an overflow agreement with a certified provider. MCG advised the Commission of this decision in MCG’s Request for Conditional Certification or for Waiver, filed September 29, 2011. In order to make certain that this


