Dear Ms. Dortch:

This notice is submitted in compliance with Section 1.1206(b) of the Commission's Rules.

On Monday, September 7, 2011, Brandy Doyle of Prometheus Radio Project and Chrystiane Pereira of Media Access Project met with Joshua Cinelli, Media Advisor to Commissioner Copps, and afterwards with Dave Grimaldi, Chief of Staff and Media Legal Advisor to Commissioner Clyburn, about issues in the above-captioned dockets.

In both meetings, Ms. Doyle discussed the Commission's proposed methodology for the assessment of LPFM availability in the Third Notice of Proposed Rulemaking in Docket 99-25. Ms. Doyle discussed a proposal, jointly filed by Prometheus, Common Frequency, and REC Networks, to adjust the Commission's methodology to better ensure adequate availability for future LPFM licensing in areas of significant population. In the meeting with Mr. Cinelli, she also discussed the dilemmas facing full-power non-commercial stations with expiring construction permits awarded in the 2007 filing window, emphasizing the plight of permit holders facing unforeseen economic difficulties. In the meeting with Mr. Grimaldi, she raised the idea of bringing a small group of LPFM operators and advocates to meet with Commissioner Clyburn in the future.
