Re: Withdrawal of application for review

Dear Mr. Havens:

On May 19, 2010, you filed, on behalf of Verde Systems LLC, Environmental LLC, Intelligent Transportation & Monitoring Wireless LLC, Telesaurus Holdings GB LLC, and Skybridge Spectrum Foundation (Petitioners), an application for review of the Mobility Division's denial¹ of a petition for reconsideration filed by some of the Petitioners of the Mobility Division's partial grant and partial denial² of a request for declaratory ruling filed by Maritime Communications/Land Mobile, LLC. On November 9, 2011, Petitioners sought to withdraw the application for review. We have reviewed Petitioners' request, and conclude, based on the circumstances presented, that good cause exists to permit them to withdraw the application for review.

Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that, pursuant to Section 4(i) of the Communications Act of 1934, as amended, 47 U.S.C. § 154(i), and Section 1.8 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R § 1.8, the request to withdraw filed by Verde Systems LLC, Environmental LLC, Intelligent Transportation & Monitoring Wireless LLC, Telesaurus Holdings GB LLC, and Skybridge Spectrum Foundation on November 9, 2011 IS GRANTED. This action is taken under delegated authority pursuant to Section 0.131 and 0.331 of the Commission's Rules, 47 C.F.R §§ 0.131, 0.331.
