

Internet provider CenturyLink (and a number of big telecoms like AT&T have) has data caps that unfairly exempt their own online video services and content from competition. This should be illegal under Network Neutrality rules of nondiscrimination guaranteeing an equal and free/open internet. Either data caps should equally apply to ISPs online services or there be no caps at all. Push for the FCC to investigate anti competitive behavior of the telecoms that violates Net Neutrality. Big telecommunications carriers engaging in discrimination should not qualify for Universal Service Funding support. To get support they should be required to comply with reasonable network management practices mandated by Net Neutrality.
