

Dear Sirs,

Due to the uncertainty of how the Broadband plan will be implemented, this has caused LPTV permittees to delay building construction permits for new stations, because they don't know if their investment will be lost by needing to rebuild on a new channel subsequently. Therefore, in consideration of LPTV operators, which are mostly small business owners and often minority run, we request that the FCC extend the permit deadline to construct new digital LPTV stations by three years. A similar extension was granted for displacement construction permits.

Also, in the spirit of using America's spectrum to the fullest, we request that digital LPTV operators on channel 6 be able to additionally provide an audio service on 87.7 MHz. This will allow community schools, religious organizations, colleges, minorities, women, and startup non-profit groups to broadcast on the FM dial that wouldn't otherwise have the funds that incumbent broadcasters have. LPTV operators can provide sufficient adjacent channel filtering to avoid interference to NCE channels.
