

COMMENTS

Bryan King (“King”), the Petitioner in the above-captioned rule making proceeding, through his counsel, hereby submits his Comments in this proceeding. In support of his position, King states the following:

In response to a Petition for Rule Making filed by King on August 25, 2011,¹ the Commission issued a *Notice of Proposed Rule Making*, DA 11-1712, released October 14, 2011 (“*NPRM*”), proposing the following change in the FM Table of Allotments: a change in the channel of the vacant allotment at Llano, Texas from Channel 293C3 to Channel 242C3. This change is necessary in order to grant the three contingent applications filed by King and Katherine Pyeatt that will allow Station KAJZ, Llano, Texas, to move to Channel 293A, “thereby

The three contingent applications include an application filed by King for Station KAJZ, Llano, Texas to operate on Channel 293A rather than Channel 242A (BPH-20110825ABP), an amendment to an application filed by Katherine Pyeatt, auction selectee for FM Channel 242A, Menard, Texas, to specify operation on Channel 292A in lieu of Channel 242A (BNPH-20110622AAE) and an application filed by King proposing to modify the facilities specified in his construction permit at Junction, Texas from Channel 292A to Channel 290A (BMPH-20110825ABQ).


alleviating concerns raised by KAJZ listeners regarding potential interference to their reception of KAJZ on Channel 242.”² In addition, by modifying its facilities to operate on Channel 293A, KAJZ will no longer need to operate as a Section 73.215 station as it currently does.

For the reasons set forth in King’s original Petition for Rule Making, as well as the *NPRM*, King hereby reaffirms his interest in having the above-referenced channel substitution made at Llano. King supports the proposal contained in the *NPRM* and respectfully requests that the Commission proceed with the substitution of Channel 242C3 for Channel 293C3 at Llano, Texas.
