Dear Ms. Dortch:

Commission rule 64.606(f)(2) requires VRS providers to notify the Commission of any substantive change in their TRS programs, services, and features. AT&T is a VRS provider that is currently eligible to recover from the Interstate TRS Fund. Pursuant to the Commission's Second Report and Order dated July 28, 2011, AT&T must lease or own a VRS call center and employ interpreters to staff that center to be eligible to apply for certification to continue providing VRS and recover from the Interstate TRS Fund for VRS. This letter provides the Commission with notice that AT&T has decided not to apply for certification as a VRS provider at this time, and that no later than January 8, 2012, AT&T will cease providing VRS. In accordance with Commission rules, AT&T will notify its registered users of this change no less than 30 days before exiting the VRS business.
