Notification for Westphalia Communications, Incorporated and Westphalia Broadband, Inc.


As required by 47 CFR 64.1120(e), Westphalia Communications, Incorporated (WCI) and Westphalia Broadband, Inc. (WBI), submit this correspondence to notify the Federal Communications Commission of a planned transfer of WCI toll customers to WBI.

WCI and WBI are affiliates; each is the wholly-owned subsidiary of Clinton County Telephone Company, which is, in turn, the wholly owned subsidiary of Great Lakes Comnet, Inc. WCI is scheduled to merge into WBI, with WBI being the surviving entity. There will be no change in the actual controlling entity with respect to the services and lines at issue as a result of the merger because both companies have the same parent company. The merger is therefore a “pro forma” transaction because the transfer of control over the toll operations will not result in a change in the actual controlling a party. No prior approval is required for pro forma transactions under 47 CFR 63.03(d) or 63.24(d).

1. **Names of Parties to Transaction:** Westphalia Communications, Incorporated and Westphalia Broadband, Inc.
2. **Type of Telecommunications Service to be Provided to Affected Customers:** WBI provides basic local exchange service, as well as broadband Internet services, to residential and business customers. WCI provides domestic and international toll service. After the transfer, WBI, in addition to the services that it currently provides, will provide domestic and international toll service.
3. **Date of the Transfer of Subscriber Base:** The merger and transfer of customers is scheduled to occur on December 31, 2011.

4. **Notice Sent to Affected Customers:** Customer notification letters were sent to affected customers via United States Mail on November 22, 2011. A copy of the customer notification letter is attached.
5. **Certification of Compliance:** Westphalia Broadband, Inc. hereby certifies (i) compliance with the requirement to provide advance subscriber notice, in accordance with 47 CFR 64.1120(e)(3), (ii) compliance with the obligations specified in the customer notification letters; and (iii) compliance with the other statutory and Commission requirements that apply to this streamlined process.

No action is necessary on your part, and you will not incur any charges as a result with this change. The transition is expected to be seamless. The personnel that currently support and serve your location will remain the same. Your rates, terms or conditions of service will not change as a result of this transfer. Notice of any future change to your rates, terms or conditions of service will be provided by mail.

You have the right to choose a toll service provider other than WBI if you wish. Your service will be transferred from WCI to WBI on the date provided above, even if you have arranged a preferred carrier freeze, unless you notify us prior to that date of your selection of a different toll provider. Note that any restrictions or "freezes" you may have placed on your account to block changes to your preferred toll service provider will be lifted as part of the transfer process. If you wish to reinstate such restrictions, please contact WBI after the transfer.
