On November 25, 2011, AT&T filed an *ex parte* notice in this docket regarding a telephone call from Chairman Julius Genachowski to Randall Stephenson, Chairman, Chief Executive Officer and President of AT&T Inc., and Wayne Watts, Senior Executive Vice President and General Counsel of AT&T, that occurred on November 22, 2011.<sup>1</sup> On the call, the participants discussed the timing and procedural process regarding a draft hearing designation order in this proceeding. The AT&T participants also inquired as to why the Commission did not stop its merger review clock.
