("SIC"), and Gregory Gill of Venable LLP, met with Edward Lazarus, Chief of Staff to Chairman Genachowski, Austin Schlick, General Counsel of the Commission, and Carol Matthey, Deputy Bureau Chief, Wireline Competition Bureau, and on December 2, 2011, Mr. Hee and Ms. Olds met with Mark Stone, Chief of Staff to Commissioner Michael J. Copps, and Lisa Hone, Wireline Advisor to Commissioner Copps.
