Dear Mr. Brown:

This is in reference to the "Petition for Temporary Closed Captioning Exemption" (Petition) that you filed on behalf of ReelzChannel, LLC (Petitioner) on December 29, 2010. The Petition sought a temporary exemption from the Commission's closed captioning requirements for all of Petitioner's high definition programming until March 31, 2011, while technical problems associated with the deployment of high definition service were worked out. These technical problems were preventing the captioning of the programs.

By letter dated November 2, 2011, you advised the Commission that the problems have been resolved and that Petitioner has implemented closed captioning. Accordingly, you state, the Petition is now moot.

Accordingly, we will dismiss the "Petition for Temporary Closed Captioning Exemption" as moot and consider the matter closed.
