I am writing pursuant to Section 1.1206(b)(2) of the Commission's Rules to notify the Commission that on December 6, 2011, Jennifer McCarthy and Jim O'Connor of NextWave Broadband, Inc., Ron Olexa of Horizon Wi-Com, LLC, and the undersigned, on behalf of the WCS Coalition, met with Julius Knapp, Ron Repasi, and Patrick Forster of the Office of Engineering and Technology, Linda Chang of the Wireless Telecommunications Bureau (participating by telephone), and Chip Fleming of the International Bureau to review the analysis filed by the WCS Coalition on December 1, 2011 in a report entitled "Simulation of TD-LTE User Equipment Transmissions in the WCS Band." During the course of the meeting, we discussed both the demonstration that the 50 mW/MHz power spectral density limit on mobile handsets in of Section 27.50(a)(3) of the Commission's Rules unnecessarily precludes the use of Long Term Evolution ("LTE") technology, and the need for modifications to Section 27.50(a)(3) to allow LTE deployment.
