On December 5, 2011, Richard Whitt of Google Inc., Paula Boyd of Microsoft, Inc., Harold Feld of Public Knowledge, Michael Calabrese of the New America Foundation, Stephen Coran as counsel for the Wireless Internet Service Providers Association, and the undersigned met with Commissioner Robert McDowell and Angela Giancarlo, Legal Advisor for Commissioner McDowell about the above-referenced proceeding. During this meeting, we: (1) stated that any grant from Congress of voluntary incentive auction authority should provide the agency with flexibility to ensure an appropriate mix of licensed and unlicensed broadband spectrum in the TV bands; (2) discussed the importance of the FCC continuing to move ahead on white spaces proceedings; and (3) thanked Commissioner McDowell for his ongoing support for white spaces technologies.
