After thorough review and investigation of all relevant facts, the Schools and Libraries Division (SLD) of the Universal Service Administrative Company (USAC) has made its decision in regard to your appeal of USAC's Funding Year 2009 Administrator's Decision on Invoice Deadline Extension Request Letter for the Application Number indicated above. This letter explains the basis of USAC's decision. The date of this letter begins the 60 day time period for appealing this decision to the Federal Communications Commission (FCC). If your Letter of Appeal included more than one Application Number, please note that you will receive a separate letter for each application.

Decision on Appeal: **Denied**
Explanation:

- Current invoice deadline guidelines and procedures require that Invoice Deadline Extension requests be filed by the end of the relevant invoice receipt period (120 days after the end of the service delivery date) for the service category of the FRN requiring an extension. USAC denied your request for Invoice Deadline Extension because the request was not filed in a timely manner. Since USAC's decision was consistent with Invoice Deadline Extension guidelines, your appeal is denied.

However, based on the additional information provided in your appeal, an Invoice Deadline Extension has been granted for FRN 1875841 despite the denial of your

appeal. You will have 120 days from the date of this decision letter to submit an invoice

If you believe there is a basis for further examination of your application, you may file an appeal with the FCC. You should refer to CC Docket No. 02-6 on the first page of your appeal to the FCC. Your appeal must be POSTMARKED within 60 days of the above date on this letter. Failure to meet this requirement will result in automatic dismissal of your appeal.
