

AT&T Inc., is a wireless spectrum hog. Ma Bell which wanted a Ma Cell over wireless by taking over T-Mobile and getting Qualcomm wireless spectrum proposed to divest up to 40 or 50% of T-Mobile's wireless assets including spectrum and customers to smaller wireless carriers starved of spectrum like MetroPCS and/or Leap Wireless (Cricket) that they would need to expand with 4G services to save its T-Mobile deal after Justice blocked it. I urge the FCC also blocking T-Mobile takeover to deny Qualcomm transaction also. It was found competition from Verizon Wireless and others would force AT&T to increase deployment 4G LTE mobile broadband whether or not the merger happened. So AT&T's comments about a spectrum shortage don't add up. It says it lacks spectrum and needs T-Mobile to improve its services but then offers to sell about 40% of T-Mobile's spectrum to smaller carriers to save its merger. So why should they get Qualcomm wireless spectrum? AT&T under-invests in their network. Investment per subscriber: (Source NoTakeover.org) AT&T Mobility (average) makes \$81 investment in network per subscriber. Industry average excluding AT&T \$91 investment per subscriber Other carriers are investing more in their wireless networks than AT&T.
