

Deutsche Telekom AG should find another buyer for T-Mobile USA a deal with whom won't be anti competitive. As such Qualcomm should also find another buyer than either AT&T or Verizon Wireless (which wants to buy unused wireless spectrum from cable companies) to do so as well. I again urge regulators to deny the Qualcomm transaction also unless serious regulatory conditions are placed on that transaction including some divestitures. In crafting conditions keep in mind short term regulatory conditions are no good we need long term consumer protections. For AT&T's Bell South merger they were required to comply with Net Neutrality for 2 years (as a regulatory condition) and couldn't even lobby on the issue during those 2 years after which they've started fighting against Net Neutrality rules to keep the Internet open. Don't put short term conditions on the sale that can expire and empower AT&T to harm consumers afterward. Only long term regulatory requirements should be imposed if transaction is approved.
