Yesterday Tamara Preiss and John Scott of Verizon met with Trent Harkrader, Chief, Telecommunications Access Policy Division, Wireline Competition Bureau. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the Commission's new rule phasing out legacy universal service high cost support to competitive eligible telecommunications carriers (CETCs) and application of that rule to Verizon Wireless' 2008 voluntary merger commitment to phase out its CETC support over five years. We discussed the scope of the Verizon Wireless commitment and the Verizon Wireless-Alltel acquisition order, both of which state that a new Commission rule of general applicability implementing a reduction in support to CETCs shall apply to Verizon Wireless instead of the more specific merger commitment.
