Yesterday, Charles McKee, Michael Fingerhut and I, all of Sprint Nextel Corp., met with Victoria Goldberg, John Hunter, Travis Litman and Pamela Arluk of the Wireline Competition Bureau regarding the traffic pumping section of the November 18 *ICC/USF Comprehensive Reform Order* in the above-captioned proceedings. Sprint discussed implementation issues associated with the new rules addressing traffic pumping schemes, and explained how some local exchange carriers may attempt to circumvent the rules as written in order to maximize their traffic pumping revenues.
