Dear Ms. Dortch:

On December 5, 2011, CenturyLink submitted its response to the Commission's Public Notice¹ requesting data in connection with the Commission's *Special Access NPRM*.² It has come to CenturyLink's attention that its response to Question III.B.1 inadvertently omitted revenue data for certain services provided by CenturyLink.

Enclosed with the highly confidential version of this letter is a CD containing CenturyLink's revised response to Question III.B.1 (that is, the spreadsheet), along with the other spreadsheets provided in CenturyLink's December 5 submission (no changes have been made to the other spreadsheets for which copies are again being provided for the Commission's ease of review). All of the spreadsheets on the CD contain highly confidential data and therefore are covered by CenturyLink's request for highly confidential treatment in its December 5 submission. The CD being filed today replaces in its entirety the one provided on December 5.

Two hard copies of a redacted version of this letter (which includes the same text except for the confidentiality markings) are also being separately filed today in the above-captioned matter. For the redacted version of the submission, the CD containing spreadsheets with highly confidential data has been omitted.
